# Raku Workshop september 20, 2009

## Workshop Information

Materials you should bring:

- ◆ 4 pots guaranteed to be fired
- ◆ 2 additional that may be fired depending on how much we get done.
- ◆ 4 - 2 x 3" pieces that may fit in for extra smoke painting.
- ◆ One of the small pieces should be burnished but is not a requirement. need info on burnishing, call me.
- ◆ Ideally you should use a raku clay body. A low fire red earthenware stoneware clay may work as well.
- ◆ If you have fire gloves, bring them.
- ◆ A pair of grilling tongs-not state-of-the-art, just tongs.
- ◆ Not required but if you have dog hair and/or cat fur / feathers/ anyone's bring it. (I'm low on feathers)
- ◆ Watch this or any You Tube clip on raku firing so you can envision will be like to remove your pots from the firing.

Pots should be no larger than 6"x 10" tall. Do not bring flat work/wide plates as they will not fit in the kiln for a group firing. If you have and want to bring one "just in case" do so but the likelihood of it fitting is not good.
